# Christ is not far away

The grace of Christian prayer is that "Christ is not far away but is always in relationship with us," Pope Francis says.

This is because "there is no aspect of the divine-human person that cannot become for us, a place of salvation and happiness," he said. Thus, "every moment of Jesus' earthly life, through the grace of prayer, can become contemporary with us" and there is no page in the Gospels in which there is no place for us. In this manner, thanks to the Holy Spirit, we too are present at the river Jordan when Jesus is baptized, we are diners at the wedding feast of Cana when Jesus gives the best wine for the happiness of the couple, we too witness in amazement the thousands of healings performed by Our Lord. At the same time, "we are the cleansed leper, the blind Bartimaeus who regains his sight and Lazarus who comes out of the tomb." For us Christians, the Pope concludes, "meditating is a way of encountering Jesus. And in this way, only in this way, can we find ourselves."
