Rooske Cemetery.

We wish to advise that Meath County Council, after a considerable amount of work and talks, have given notice that the cemetery at Rooske will now be extended to the rear of the existing burial ground on the Rooske Road which the council have purchased. Works have already commenced and you are advised that there will be traffic delays due to these works and to avoid the area if at all possible.

Meath County Council will allocate, manage and maintain all burial plots in the extended area which is being developed as a Lawn Burial Garden and where no graveside kerbs will be permitted. Pre-booking of grave spaces will not be permitted.

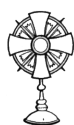
